## 2026 International Gaming Summit Agenda Now Available

The International Association of Gaming Advisors (“IAGA”) has posted the agenda for its 43rd International Gaming Summit, scheduled for June 2–4, 2026, at The Ritz-Carlton in Sarasota, Florida.

## Upcoming Webinars Hosted by the National Council on Problem Gambling

The National Council on Problem Gambling (NCPG) will [host](#) two educational webinars in February focused on problem gambling treatment and emerging issues in the gambling industry.

On Friday, February 6, 2026, from 1:00 p.m. to 2:00 p.m. Eastern, NCPG will present an “Ask Me Anything” session on problem gambling treatment and recovery. The program will feature Jody Bechtold, a nationally recognized expert in gambling disorder treatment, and will explore how individuals and families can navigate treatment options, identify qualified providers, and understand evidence-based approaches tailored to different populations and types of gambling.

NCPG will also host a webinar titled “Understanding the Rise of Prediction Markets in

Gambling” on Tuesday, February 10, 2026, from 1:00 p.m. to 2:00 p.m. Eastern. This program will examine prediction markets and their growing use as gambling platforms, as well as the regulatory, responsible gambling, and consumer protection challenges that arise as the boundaries between investing and betting continue to blur.

The February 6 webinar is free and open to the public with registration. The February 10 webinar is free for NCPG members and available to non-members for a registration fee. Continuing education credits are not available for either program.
